## Nature and purpose of funds

Because 2017 was a transitional year receipts and payments in the year related mostly to the Path Wardens fund. This is expected to change in 2018 in keeping with our

At 31 December 2017 the accumulated balances on the two funds were £0 on the ELCV General Fund and £2,304 on the Path Wardens Fund.
